RSC Delegate Report April 13 2022

Member Concerns

Concept 11

"In 2021 the World Service Conference (WSC) was virtual. A few members went to Torrance, CA to host the WSC. This included the WSC Facilitator, the Parliamentarian, and the two WSC Secretaries. The Board of Trustees, Delegates, Alternate Delegates, support team, and visitors attended remotely via Zoom.

During the 2021 WSC the voting members approved a motion to always provide a virtual option for future WSC events. The vote was unanimously in favor, with a couple abstentions. Following the 2021 WSC the WSC planning committee created a proposal for the 2023 WSC and recommended to the Board of Trustees that the 2023 WSC allow for remote participation.

Based on this information, I suggested the Central California Region (CCR) review the 2022 budget and not budget funds for an in-person WSC, and instead give those funds directly to the support of the WSO. This approach was adopted by both the RSC and the Assembly.

According to the 2023 WSC Invitation memorandum dated March 1, 2022, the 2023 WSC will be held inperson in Torrance, CA. The exact amount the region will need to pay for our Delegate to go is not yet determined, but the prices for the hotel, travel, and meals have all gone up since the contract with the hotel was signed in 2019. In the 2021 CCR Adopted Budget, \$1,250 per year was budgeted for equalized expense and incidentals for an estimated total of \$2,500 to send each delegate to the WSC.

I suggest the CCR RSC discuss this topic in our April meeting.

I believe we might want to take a recommendation to the July Assembly to revise our 2022 budget.

Do we want to switch back to saving money for the 2023 WSC instead of increasing our contribution to WSO? Or do we want to continue an increased contribution to WSO and also set aside funds for the 2023 WSC?"

Responsible or Control?

"The meeting after the meeting continued for about 20 minutes today and I said I needed to go. Another member offered to take over as host, but I said we do not do that in our region.

Personally, I think that if it is our Zoom room, then we have a responsibility to monitor what goes on in the room. I do not want to find out our room was used to express harmful words toward other members. I have seen it happen before in other groups where I was a guest.

When I had the key to the physical room, it was my responsibility to be sure the room was closed and locked before I left. I think of Zoom in the same way."
